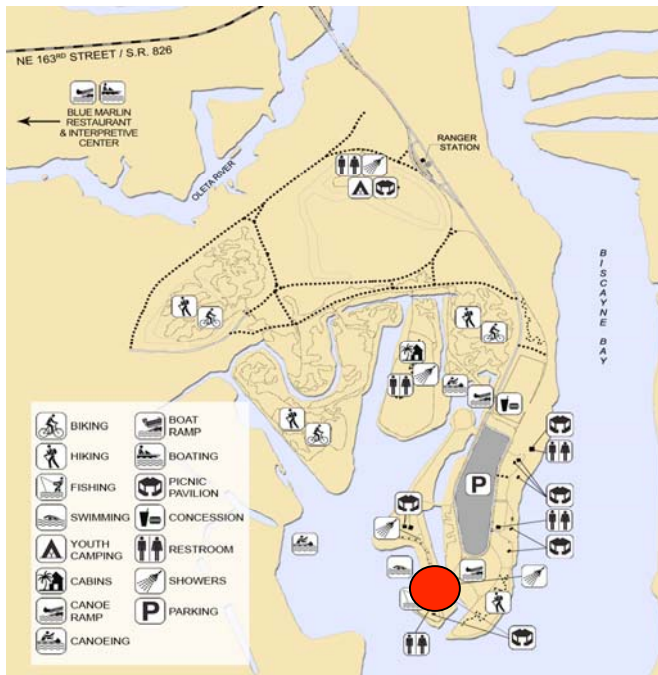


# Paradise Picnic

## Oleta River State Park

Oleta River State Park offers 15 miles of mountain-bike trails, a beautiful man-made beach, rustic log cabins for camping, and nine picnic pavilions available to rent for your next event. The Blue Moon Outdoor Center rents canoes, kayaks, and bikes. The Blue Marlin Fish House Restaurant offers great food, and while you're there, visit the Interpretive Center's computerized presentation.

Oleta River State Park was recently honored by ReserveAmerica in the 2010 Outdoor Awards: **Top 25 Biking Trails**, **Top 50 Fishing Spots**, **Top 25 Park Beaches**, **Top 25 Picnic Areas**, **Top 25 Romantic Spots**, **Top 50 Scenic Views** and **Top 25 Unique Cabins**. ### From Miami, FL

1. Head **east** on **NW 15th St** toward **NW 18th Ave** (0.2 mi)
2. Take the 2nd **left** onto **NW 17th Ave** (1.4 mi)
3. Turn **right** at **NW 36th St** (2.2 mi)
4. Turn **left** at **US-1 N/Biscayne Blvd** (8.5 mi)
5. Turn **right** at **NE 163rd St/Sunny Isles Blvd** Destination will be on the right (0.8 mi)

### From Fort Lauderdale, FL

1. Head **west** on **E Broward Blvd** toward **N Andrews Ave** (1.6 mi)
2. Turn **left** at **SW 20th Terrace** (0.2 mi)
3. Merge onto **I-95 S** via the ramp to **Miami** (10.5 mi)
4. Take exit 16 toward **NE 203 St/Ives Dairy Rd** (0.2 mi)
5. **Keep** left at the fork, follow signs for **US-1** (423 ft)
6. Turn **left** at **NE 199th St/Ives Dairy Rd** Continue to follow Ives Dairy (1.2 mi)
7. Turn **right** at **Biscayne Blvd** (2.7 mi)
8. Turn **left** at **NE 163rd St/Sunny Isles Blvd** Destination will be on the right (0.8 mi)
