

SCOTTISH SUMMER SCHOOL 2006

This year we offer two venues for accommodation. These are detailed below. Both types of venue are self-catering.

ACCOMMODATION TYPE 1 - Albany Park, St Andrews University.

Accommodation consists of a room with a single bed. Each house comprises of a kitchen, 3 single bedrooms and toilet and shower on the ground floor and 3 single bedrooms, a living room and toilet on the first floor.

The kitchen has a cooker, refrigerator/freezer, breakfast bar and stools. Hot water and electricity are included in the cost. There is a TV point in the living room and a television can be hired locally.

The houses are furnished and equipped with essential items of crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils and cleaning equipment. The beds have duvets and linen for them is provided. However, residents **NEED TO BRING THEIR OWN TOWELS AND TEA-TOWELS**. Laundry facilities are available.

ACCOMMODATION TYPE 2 – David Russell Apartments, St Andrews University

Each apartment has five bedrooms and a well-furnished lounge and kitchen.

Each bedroom has a double size 4ft 6ins, wide bed, en-suite shower bathroom, television and a telephone which permits calls at no extra charge throughout the University network, and outside calls using a pre-payment card which can be purchased at the residence. The rooms can be used for single or double occupancy. When occupied by two people, the bedrooms are compact.

Each bedroom is unlocked by its own key card, which also gives access only to its apartment and to the front door of the building. Access to the buildings is straightforward, but within each building there is no lift. There are ground-floor apartments for guests with limited mobility.

SESSIONS in Madras College, St Andrews.

All sessions for adults, youth and children will be held in Madras College, which is approx a 10 minute walk from Albany Park. David Russell Apartments are approx a 5-10 minute car ride.

A minibus has been arranged for all those without their own transport. The minibus will function as a shuttle service between Albany Park, David Russell Apartments and Madras College.

Wheelchair access and facilities are available in Madras College, David Russell Hall and also on the minibus.
